Oral Exam – Skit

- 1. Form a group of 2-3 students. Each student should have at least 3 minutes worth of lines (if there are 2 of you the skit should last 6 minutes, if there are three of you, 9 minutes).
- 2. Create a situation. It can be any theme from chapter vocabularies: on the phone, at a hotel, traveling, meeting someone, going somewhere, personalities, the weather, the time, etc. or any other themes related to the class.
- 3. Write the script. Keep it simple and use words and verb tenses you've learned during the semester. If you don't know the word, your peers most likely will not know it either and won't understand what you are saying during the skit. The class is your audience so cater your performance to them.
- 4. Practice the skit and learn it so that you can do it without reading. Make sure to time it.
- 5. Create 3 listening comprehension questions in Spanish to be distributed to the class before your skit.
- 6. Students will be graded <u>on an individual basis</u>, so do not rely on your group to pull your weight.
- 7. The final product should be polished, well rehearsed, and show creativity and imagination.
- 8. Please show respect for your fellow students and not create a skit that is distasteful or offensive.

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
